What is re-parenting?

An adopted child may have experienced neglect, trauma and/or abuse in addition to separation from the birth parents. Because of the past, this child may not be able to reciprocate love. Re-parenting reaches back into those early developmental stages and to repair the damaged past.

Interactive training:

- Parents and professionals are given tools to assemble a therapeutic team that will redirect the child, process and reframe behaviors and support the family.
- Parents and professionals are guided in designing healing environments.
- Parents and professionals are equipped with tools and interventions designed for the child.
- Learn by: role-play, visuals, case studies, lecture, resource materials, rehearsing and worksheets, etc.
